Community Green Travel Network

At Stockley Park the sustainability of the world around us is of utmost importance. Providing sustainable, healthy and financially sound travel options to occupiers is continually being explored.

Since 2017 Stockley Park has been running a green travel scheme, which sets medium term targets to reduce car-mode share and introduce multiple measures to facilitate demonstrable mode shift away from the car.

Members have seen many benefits, including the introduction of a free shuttle service, discounted electric charging units, successful collaboration and development of partnerships with local community groups, discounted rail tickets, and extensive travel plan engagement, monitoring and analysis.

Understanding what the community needs and wants has been imperative to the whole process so a popular program of roadshows and occupier travel forums have been established to provide two-way discussion. By leading travel surveys with occupiers, Stockley Park has been able to work on improving the free flow travel throughout the park and establish links with our local community. Continuous engagement takes place with many external parties, including the Development Control, Road Safety and Travel Plan teams at London Borough of Hillingdon, Cross Rail for the Elizabeth Line, local bus operators and Transport for London.



Representation has been provided at the Heathrow Area Transport Forum, and transport Steering Group meetings. It is with such links Stockley Park was able to work with the Canal River Trust to lobby the local borough of Hillingdon for vital improvements to the canal towpath, which now provides a scenic and level walkway for Stockley Park occupiers and local ramblers alike.

Plans for the Future

Although there have been many benefits already put in place for our occupiers, the green travel scheme is always looking forward at ways we can improve.

- Stockley Park is in discussions with NextBike to extend the Hillingdon Santander Bike Scheme to Stockley Park.
- The popular shuttle service is looking to be updated to have a new digital layer to the booking app, easily allowing users to book the service in real time rather than to a set timetable.
- E-scooters are becoming more popular with private users and there may be the opportunity to provide a rental scheme for occupiers.
